ANNUAL PARENTS' SURVEY, SPRING 2014

Thank you to all who took the time to complete the short survey. Governors are keen to hear your views and are pleased to report that responses have been overwhelmingly positive. Information you have supplied will help the school to continue to improve. This is a short report giving you feedback on the results. Results with the highest percentage response are shown in bold type.

SECTION 1

We asked you which year group your child or children are in. These are the results.



The total number of responses to section 1 was 63 reflecting a number of responses with children in more than one year group.

SECTION 2

We asked 6 questions about your child or children. These are the results. As you will see, in all of the questions the majority of responses either agreed strongly or agreed.
