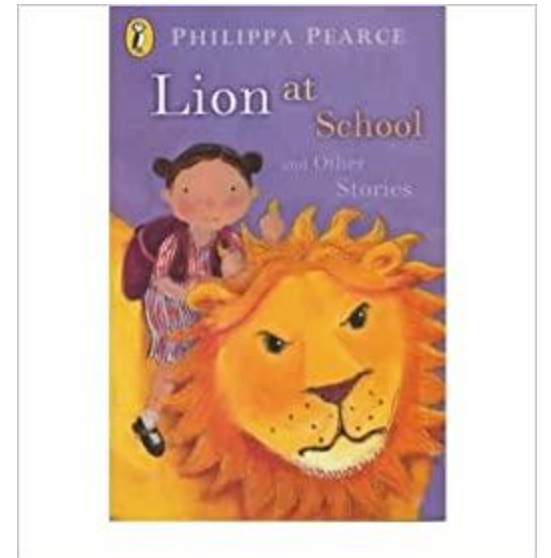
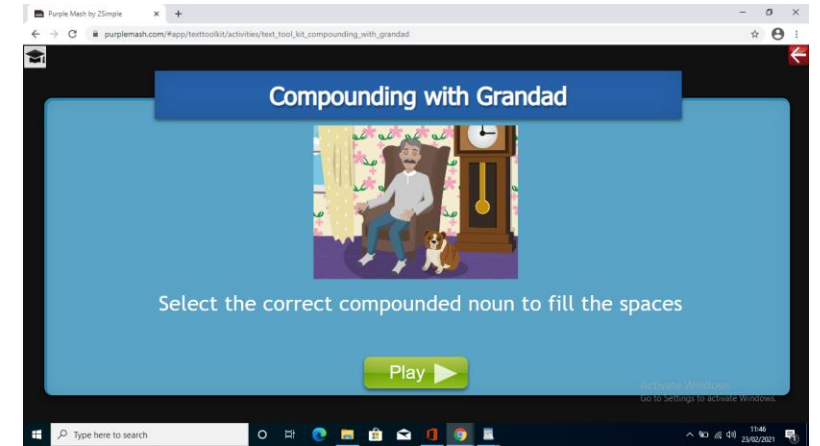

Starter - Purple Mash



A starter has been set for you on purple mash

Success criteria: Here are some of the things you should be able to do by the end of today's lesson.

To plan a new story.

What is the animal?

Where is it going to go?

Today you will be planning a story about an animal going somewhere they shouldn't



You can have your animal go
anywhere you like.



Here is my plan

The red writing shows the ideas I have come up with for my story.

Can you come up with ideas for your story using the boxing up plan.

Opening	What is the animal?	Elephant
Build Up	Where is it going to go?	To the park.
Problem	What is it going to do?	The elephant sees children playing on swings and roundabouts and asks to play. They say no.
Resolution	Then what is it going to do?	Then he notices that the children's football is stuck in a tree. He uses his trunk to get it down.
Ending	How will it end so all is well?	The children let him play football and he is never lonely again.
